Rising Middle Class: With a burgeoning middle class, more Vietnamese families are investing in private English education for their children, boosting demand for expat teachers.

Salary Range: Expat teachers in Vietnam can expect to earn between from \$1,200 to \$2,000 per month, depending on their qualifications and experience. This is quite competitive given the relatively low cost of living in the country.

Additional Benefits: Many schools and language centers offer benefits such as housing allowances, health insurance, and paid holidays. Some even provide bonuses and performance incentives.



While holding hands is generally acceptable, more intimate displays of affection are frowned upon in public settings.

✔ **Personal Space**

Vietnamese people may stand closer during conversations compared to Western cultures. This is a sign of friendliness, not a breach of personal space.

✔ **Non-Verbal Communication**

Smiling often and using gestures like a slight nod or bow can convey respect and appreciation. Avoid pointing with your finger; instead, use your whole hand to gesture towards something.

✔ **Gift-Giving**

When visiting someone's home, bringing a small gift like fruits, flowers, or sweets is a thoughtful gesture.

✔ **Superstitions and Beliefs**

Be mindful of local superstitions and beliefs. For instance, sweeping the floor during Tet (Lunar New Year) is believed to sweep away good luck.

✔ **Negotiation and Bargaining**

Bargaining is common in markets and small shops. Approach it with a friendly attitude and be prepared to negotiate, but always remember to keep it light-hearted and respectful.

✔ **Festivals and Holidays**

Participate in local festivals and holidays like Tet Nguyen Dan (Lunar New Year), Mid-Autumn Festival, and other cultural events. These occasions are excellent opportunities to immerse yourself in Vietnamese culture.

✔ **Temples and Pagodas**

Vietnamese people often visit temples during holidays and important occasions to pray for blessings.
